WebEXAMPLE: O2 Saturation: 88% on room air, 95% on 2 liter nasal canula. General appearance: include information on the patient’s overall condition. It is appropriate to comment on level of comfort or distress, as well as general grooming and hygiene. Example: Mr. Smith is a well appearing elderly gentleman in no acute distress.
