The Heiress vs the Establishment Constance Backhouse 2013-12-01 In 1922, Elizabeth Bethune Campbell, a Toronto-born socialite, unearthed what she initially thought was an unsigned copy of her mother's will, designating her as the primary

beneficiary of the estate.
